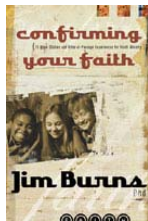

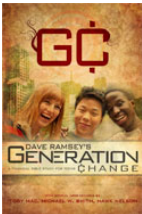

- How a lifestyle of generous giving can change the world around them forever.

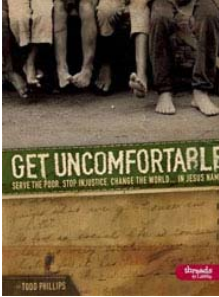

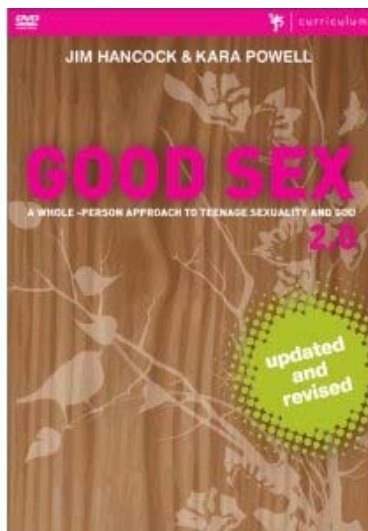

Based on the bestseller, Help! I'm a Small Group Leader, you'll find this to be a great resource for use with your volunteers and youth ministry team.

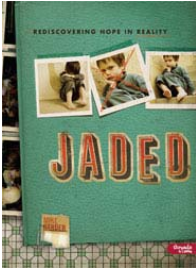


*Jaded: Rediscovering Hope in Reality. by Mike Harder. © 2007 LifeWay Press.

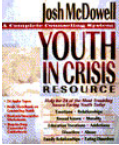
