## Maui Missions Newsletter

Aloha mai kakou -Greetings to everyone.

First of all, thank you very much for the Christmas and birthday cards. In Hawaii everything is summer. Time and seasons are not felt, so cards remind us. Also, many thanks for the financial giving. We are a blessed couple through your gifts and prayers.

Our mission is our mantra: **WIN, BUILD** and **SEND**. Win people to Christ through preaching the Gospel. Build people in Christ through Discipleship. And, Send people for Christ through ministry.

We started 2020 with a January 13 baptism of two converts: Robin Muto and Cammi Hawkins. They were baptized at the Muto's resident saline pool in Launiupoko, Maui. Robin is an office administrator of her husband James' cardiology practice in Kahului, Maui. Cammi works at the cardiologist center and will attend school to further her position in the cardiology field. Many elderly in the church and community go to Dr. Muto for their heart care.


