In addition to the COVID-19 struggles, the value of the Haitian gourde is dropping and food prices are increasing, making daily life more difficult for the Haitian. Please keep this country in your prayers.



Praise God - there are some positive things to report!! Project Help Haiti was given some generous donations to be able to provide masks for our staff and their families at our compounds in Pierre Payen and Borel. 850 adult masks and 350 children's masks were made and purchased in Haiti. This gave work to local Haitians, helped their economy and provided some health benefits to our workers. Thank you to those who gave to make this possible. Also – the gang violence, kidnappings, and roadblocks have been fewer and fewer, making travel in Haiti less dangerous and more capable. We thank God that He is always working!!



Thank you for your prayers and financial support as we continue to serve God in the US and in Haiti. We do not know when we will be able to return to Haiti, but we wait, trust God, and continue to serve Him here in Missouri. We are very thankful that Rod has been able to work during this COVID crisis and keep his employs on full-time.
