

# Kenya Missions Update

## Prayer Requests

The Voice of the Gospel Ministry is working with 12 pastors in Kenya with 15 churches spread in central Kenya, Embu, Kathageri, Kagio Sagana, Sagana, Kanjai, Baricho, and Mwea. Western Kenya has 7 pastors and 10 churches, Kitui has five pastors and seven churches bordering Garrissa which is a Muslim territory where our churches have been under attack.

So far none of our church members have been infected with Covid-19. but the effects of the pandemic have created widespread need. Most of the churches have opened their doors in the last three weeks. We have observed a prudent utilization of the Covid-19 funds we received from the CGGC. We started by buying the relief foods which were distributed to the churches for three months. The government later gave instruction that donors can only give money to avoid people coming together. This resulted in us visiting homes with food packages. At times we have had to make cash transfers through M-pesa when the distance and the cost is very high or there are travel restrictions. The government has now insisted that we buy contactless thermometers for churches to use before they could reopen.

There are many needs for prayers as we near the end of the year. Some brethren here left for rural areas after their places of work were closed. We have never seen some of them and only communicate through the phone. Some places where we have churches have reported attacks by wild animals. In Kitui a monkey ran away with a baby and sadly the baby has not been found.

The number of people attending our services is very minimal now and this calls for more visitations and prayers. The Kitui area is the most affected as food crops have been eaten away by the monkeys. School children are still at home here and some young girls are getting pregnant.
